



Covid-19 Plans & Procedures

Lifestyle Events Management continues to actively monitor the COVID-19 virus outbreak in line with local, state and federal authorities and public health advice, including that of the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the World Health Organization (WHO), and local government agencies.

Our position remains unchanged:

The health and safety of our exhibitors, visitors and staff is our number one priority.

All staff members, volunteers, sponsors, exhibitors, and attendees will be required to follow the steps below before entering an Active After 50 Expo . Please note that an inherent risk of exposure to Covid-19 exists in any public place where people are present. Covid-19 is an extremely contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and death. By visiting an Active After 50 Expo, you voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to Covid-19. Please stay home and follow CDC guidelines if you are feeling sick, have had a fever, or have been around anyone diagnosed with Covid-19. Expo staff reserves the right to deny entry to any individual.

To that end we are initiating an on-line pre-registration for attendees and, for those attendees who have not pre-registered, an on-site registration will be required. During this process contact information will be collected and the following steps will apply to all exhibitors/sponsors, Expo staff, volunteers, attendees, etc.:

1. All visitors must have their temperature checked before entering the building.
2. Visitors may be asked to fill out a short questionnaire. Questions may include, "Have you previously been diagnosed with Covid-19?, Have you traveled out of the state in the previous 3 months?, etc."
1. Visitors may be asked to sign a waiver.
2. All visitors must wear a face mask. One will be provided at the entrance if you do not have one.
3. All visitors will be given hand sanitizer to use throughout the day.

Steps Taken by Lifestyle Events Management

1. Booths will be spaced 6' apart.
2. A clear path will be visible for visitors to follow as they walk through the booth spaces.
3. Attendees are encouraged to converse with exhibitors one family or group at a time.
4. Exhibitors are encouraged to take further steps to ensure social distancing at their booth.
5. We are working closely with our venue partners to ensure they are acting in accordance with the advice of public health authorities. All have strengthened hygiene and sanitation and protocols are in place based on guidance from local and state public health authorities.
6. The number of people inside the venue will be monitored.
