



Covid-19 Plans & Procedures

Updated January 1, 2022

The Active After 50 Group continues to monitor the COVID-19 virus outbreak in line with local, state and federal authorities and public health advice, including that of the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the World Health Organization (WHO), and local government agencies.

Our position remains unchanged:

The health and safety of our exhibitors, visitors and staff is our number one priority.

Please note that an inherent risk of exposure to Covid-19 exists in any public place where people are present. Covid-19 is an extremely contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and death. By visiting an Active After 50 Expo, you voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to Covid-19. Please stay home and follow CDC guidelines if you are feeling sick, have had a fever, or have been around anyone diagnosed with Covid-19. Expo staff reserves the right to deny entry to any individual.

To that end we are initiating an on-line pre-registration for attendees and, for those attendees who have not pre-registered, an on-site registration will be required.

Additional Steps Taken by the Active After 50 Group

1. Attendees are encouraged to converse with exhibitors one family or group at a time.
2. Exhibitors are encouraged to take further steps to ensure social distancing at their booth.
3. We are working closely with our venue partners to ensure they are acting in accordance with the advice of public health authorities. All have strengthened hygiene and sanitation and protocols are in place based on guidance from local and state public health authorities.
